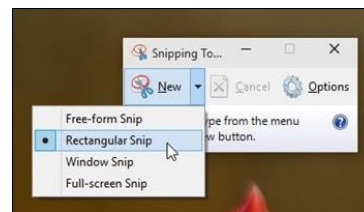

Open Snipping Tool and take a Screenshot



- To open Snipping Tool, type **Snipping Tool** in the search box on the taskbar (bottom left corner), and then select **Snipping Tool**.

- To take a screenshot with Snipping Tool, select **New**, and then select the part of the screen that you want to capture. Choose from free-form, rectangular, window, or full-screen snips by selecting the arrow on the **New** button.

- After you create the snip, you can draw on it with the built-in pens, save it, copy it, or email it to someone.
