SPINACH-FETA CROSTINI'S

INGREDIENTS

1 (10 ounce) package frozen chopped spinach, thawed and drained

2 small tomatoes, diced

1 small onion, diced

1 clove garlic, minced

½ cup crumbled feta cheese

1/4 cup mayonnaise

1/4 cup sour cream

1/4 teaspoon pepper

16 ounces French bread, cut into 1/2 inch slices

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Mix together all of the ingredients except the bread.
- (If making ahead, cover and refrigerate until needed.) Spread mixture on each slice of bread, place on a baking sheet, and bake at 350 for 18-20 minutes or until golden.
- 6-8 Servings


