

Congratulations to the IRS certified volunteer tax preparers from Mount Airy Public Library/ Surry County Senior Center. This was the 1<sup>st</sup> year partnering with the IRS to provide free tax preparation through the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program. VITA offers free tax help to people who generally make \$55,000 or less, persons with disabilities and limited English-speaking taxpayers who need assistance in preparing their own tax returns. IRS-certified volunteers provide free basic income tax return preparation with electronic filing to qualified individuals.
