Operates from June through October for children ages 6 weeks to 5 years. Provides comprehensive family support and child development services for children of Migrant Farm workers who have moved to Surry or Yadkin County within the last 24 months; and for seasonal families who no longer move but continue to work in agriculture as their main source of income.
