YVEDDI Jones Family Resource Center is delighted to announce the donation of a new directional sign. The project began as an Eagle Scout project for Grant Routh but it was derailed by circumstances surrounding COVID-19. However, a pandemic did not stop this scout from completing the project.

Grant with his grandfather, Roger Routh installed the new Jones Family Resource Center and Auditorium sign at the corner of Jones School Road and North Main Street on August 10, 2021.

Steve Barnard of Interstate Sign Company designed and donated the metal sign. Grant and Roger purchased the lumber and building materials and Grant designed and created the wood framing for the sign project. The trio did a wonderful job making this project come to fruition and it has received numerous compliments from the community. Grant will be attending UNC- Wilmington this fall and has plans for a medical career. We wish him well on his future endeavors. Roger Routh, owner of Hutchens Cleaners, is a huge supporter of the JFRC and has been a long-standing member of the Jones Family Resource Center Advisory Council.





In David's previous work experience as a director and manager he has had responsibility in budgetary compliance, safety, oversight of personnel and equipment maintenance, marketing and operational management. We expect David to bring his previous work experience to the position and be a great asset to our agency. David's first day of work was August 10th.
